Entry Rules and Information

Entry Fee prior to October 15, 2010

- \$115.00 per indoor space
- \$90.00 per outdoor space
- Double or triple space available at the same fee per space

Entry Fee after October 15, 2010

- \$130.00 per indoor space
- \$105.00 per outdoor space
- Double or triple space available at the same fee per space.

Indoor/Outdoor Space

- Vary in size and shape depending upon location; due to layout of the school
- Most individual spaces are approximately 9'x9', 8'x10' or 10' x 10'
- Participants must furnish their own display materials and equipment
- One table and 2 chairs will be provided if needed. **If not, please indicate this on your application form.**
- Extra tables are available if needed for \$7.00 per table. **Please indicate this on your application.**
- All tables must be covered and draped; creates a professional look and is more pleasing to the customer's eye.
- Electricity will be provided free of charge to the best of our ability, without guarantee, **only if you request so on your application.**

**** You must provide your own extension cords, 25 ft. 50 ft. or 100 ft.****

Applications for Past Participants

- **Must** be received, **in the mail, along with a check made out to Madison Spirit Club**, by October 13, 2010 to **reserve last year's** indoor/outdoor space
- **After October 13, 2010, applications will be accepted on a space availability basis only, as determined by date of receipt.**
- **Final** deadline for registration is October 23, 2010
- All payments made after October 23, 2010, **must be** made with cash, money order, or cashier's check.
- Applications will be considered incomplete until **all** information (application, release acknowledgment, and picture of your product(s)) is received.
- A **confirmation letter** will be sent acknowledging your participation.

****Any forms that are incomplete may cause your space assignment to be delayed****

Applications for New Participants

- Must be received, **in the mail, along with a check made out to Madison Spirit Club**, as soon as possible; early applications have a better chance of participating

- *Will be accepted on a space availability basis, as determined by date of receipt*
- *Space availability is determined upon past participants' applications received prior to October 13, 2010.*
- **Final** deadline for registration is October 23, 2010
- **All payments made after October 23, 2010, must be made with cash, money order, or cashier's check.**
- Applications will be considered incomplete until **all** information (application, release acknowledgment, picture of your product(s)) is received.
- A **confirmation letter** will be sent acknowledging your participation.

****Any forms that are incomplete may cause your space assignment to be delayed****

Participation

- Registered participants are expected to participate in the show both days.
- Registered participants are expected to remain open for business until the show's closing time. (Remember, as soon as customers see a participant closing, the customer will stop buying.)
- Tear down may begin on Sunday at 4:45 p.m.

*****Future participation rights may be affected if these expectations are not followed*****

Cancellation

- Please notify Michelle Ingrassia-Duarte by mail.
- If notification is received **on or before** October 23, 2010, entrée fee will be refunded.
- **After** October 23, 2010, entrée fee will be refunded **only if** your cancelled registration can be replaced by another participant.

Late applications

- *Will be accepted after October 23, 2010, based on space availability and date of receipt.*
- **Remember, all payments made after October 23, 2010, must be made with cash, money order, or cashier's check.**

General Information

- The premises are expected to be vacated by 6:30 P.M. on Sunday, November 14, 2010.
- Unloading and setting up may start at 6:30 a.m. on Saturday, November 13, 2010; a limited number of students will be available to help you unload Saturday morning and to load Sunday. Please remember to display your items within your own indoor/outdoor space.
- Display areas will be locked at night and security will be provided.
- **Remember, indoor/outdoor space is determined by previous show participation, postmark of application, and product type.** Although it may not always be possible, we will make every effort to keep exhibitors with similar items separated in our show.
- In the past, our show has predominantly been hand crafted items. Our expectation is that the show continues to be primarily hand crafted items. However, due to new trends toward direct marketing items, we will continue accommodating these vendors as well. We trust that our vendors value this show and will continue to honor our tradition to uphold our standards. The sponsor reserves the right to remove any objectionable items which violate community

standard of decency.

- We ask each participant, on a voluntary basis, to donate door prizes to be given out each hour throughout the show.
- Admission will be a \$1.00 donation for each attendee. This donation will help cover the cost of renting the facility, usage of custodial service, and kitchen supervision.
- Parking is free for all.
- Event advertising is through news media, fliers, posters, banners, and portable signs.
